What is MA?

Year 7 KS2 data, along with our own internal MIDYIS testing, is used to identify our most able (MA) students. Students identified as MA demonstrate the potential to be high academic achievers. The academy consistently monitors MA students' progress allowing appropriate enrichment and intervention to ensure they are extended to reach their fulfil potential.

Our expectations of our MA students remain very high, within lessons teachers ensure that all MA students are sufficiently challenged and extended within their learning. The progress of MA students is rigorously monitored on a half termly basis.

Extracurricular and Enrichment

Being part of the Most Able programme at Madeley Academy allows students the opportunity to engage in a variety of extracurricular enrichment activities focusing on raising aspirations and confidence. All MA students are given personal careers interviews by our own highly skilled careers team in each academic year. This allows us to assess students' needs and requirements and create a personalised enrichment programme for each student.
