

Frequently Asked Questions

Will there be a transition day or open day before the end of the summer term?

Due to government guidelines and recommendations, we have decided against holding the scheduled transition days and open day. We have instead set-up the **'Year 6 Transition Tab'** on the **school website with regular updates and a guided virtual tour of the school.**

What will the arrangements be for starting school in September?

During these uncertain times, it is very difficult for the school to accurately outline the arrangements for September. Following the recent advice from the government, we are expecting all Year 7 students to be back in school full-time from Wednesday 2nd September. Further discussions will be taking place in school over the coming weeks and once timetables are completed, we will intend to send them out in the post during the summer. Please be aware, we may refrain from sending out timetables and distribute them on the first day in September. We will update the website to inform students where they will need to go on the first day, so please do not worry if timetables have not been distributed beforehand. We do not want to confuse students by sending out timetables that later need to be retracted and changed. The likelihood is that year groups will have staggered start and end times, and remain in year group bubbles. School uniform from September will be the Academy uniform (blazer, trousers, shirt, tie, shoes) and NOT the PE kit as previously considered

Where can I purchase the school uniform from and school PE kit?

In preparation for September, we have been informed that our uniform suppliers, Baker and Son Schoolwear based in Wellington, is now open on an appointment only basis. Please refer to their website for further information and appointment booking details. The full expectations for PE kit and school uniform are on the school website.

What will I need to bring with me on the first day?

You will need to bring your own set of stationary (pens, pencils, ruler etc). You will be provided with the Academy bag and learning journal on the first day. You will need to bring either a packed lunch or money for lunch (unless you are entitled to free school meals).

When will I receive my starter pack?

You will be receiving a starter pack over the summer with further information about the Academy. Please be patient as we are continually updating information based on advice we are given from the government
