A full-time Teacher of History is required from 1 January 2018. The successful candidate will work under the line management of the Head of History and Head of Humanities within the faculty of Humanities, providing the advantage of leadership support in all aspects of the role.

Experience Required

It will be essential for the successful candidate to hold Qualified Teacher Status and preferably a degree in History. It would also be an advantage to have experience of teaching History to the full age and ability range to GCSE level. Experience of teaching OCR SHP would be advantageous. The post would be suitable for a newly qualified teacher as well as an experienced teacher.

Personal Qualities

It will be vital to be able to relate positively to young people, enjoy their company and be able to communicate effectively (avoiding confrontation). You will need to have a positive outlook, be resilient, have a capacity for hard work, and be committed to the Academy's child centred ethos.

We are looking for an enthusiastic person who will fit into the team and enjoy the prospect of raising standards in learning and teaching whilst contributing to the continued success of the Academy.

A high level of confidence will be needed to engage children and to utilise flexible and active learning approaches to the teaching of History.

The Department

The History department (which is part of the Humanities Faculty) currently has 4 teaching staff who have access to a range of modern and well-resourced classrooms.

The History department is led by Steph Lowe as Head of History and is supported by Geoff Hulme who as Head of Humanities leads History, Geography and the Social Sciences as part of the broader faculty.

The Curriculum

KS3

The History follows a curriculum based around the National curriculum guidelines with students taught History from the medieval era through to World War II. All students in KS3 are taught in sets.

KS4

From Year 9 students are taught the New OCR SHP History B Syllabus with units on The Elizabethans, Nazi Germany, Crime and Punishment and a local study on Coalbrookdale. All students are set in KS4.
